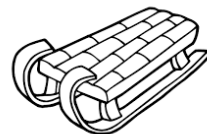
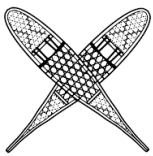

The Arctic and Antarctica are the two coldest places in the world. They are covered with snow and ice. There are no trees. In the winter, it’s dark all day and all night. Some Arctic people build houses called igloos – igloos are made of snow. People travel on sledges pulled by husky dogs. People wear clothes made of animal fur. They eat fish and meat. Seals, foxes, bears, reindeer and birds also live in the Arctic. Most of these animals eat fish. Antarctica is even colder than the Arctic. It is the windiest, iciest place in the world. Fish, birds, penguins and seals live in the Antarctica, but only about 250 people live there. In the Arctic and Antarctica you need a coat with a fur hood, gloves, boots and snowshoes.
